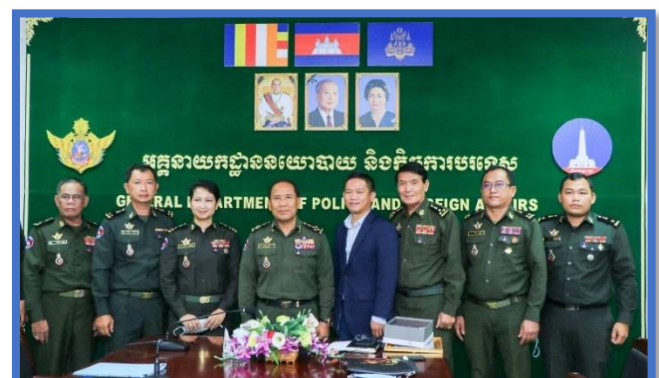

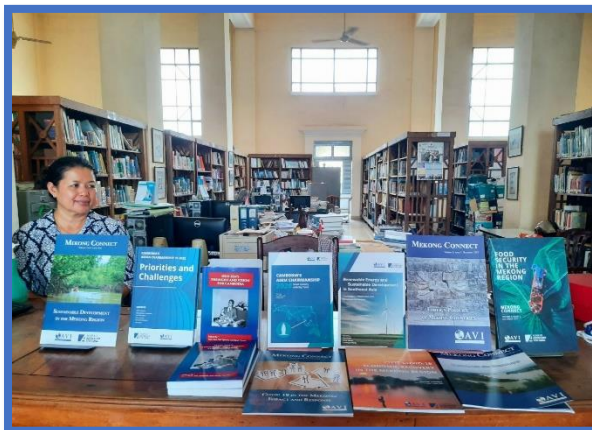

AVI's Inputs into Cambodia's Defence White Paper



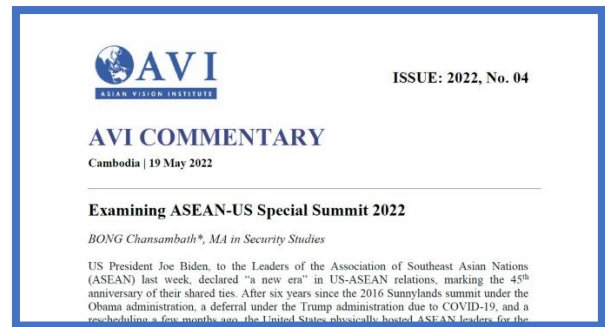
AVI is honoured to have contributed inputs into the Defence White Paper of Cambodia.

AVI Commentary on ASEAN-US Special Summit 2022



The recent ASEAN-US Special Summit in Washington, D.C., indicated the Biden administration's attempt to counter China's influence in Southeast Asia and strengthen the US' relations with ASEAN. This article argues that although the Summit produced several noticeable results, it indicated key limitations in the US engagement strategy towards the bloc. These include the lack of a clear economic plan, an underwhelming financial commitment, and a missed opportunity for bilateral dialogues between US President Joe Biden and his ASEAN counterparts.
