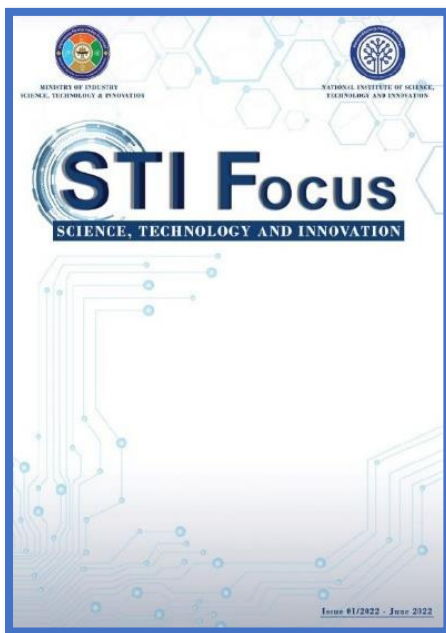

Special Session on “Parliamentary Diplomacy, Think Tank Cooperation and People-to-People Relations”



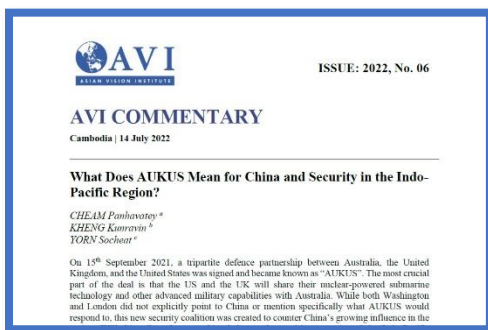
On 5 July 2022, AVI, together with the Universal Peace Federation and the Hyojeong Academic Foundation, co-organised a special session at the National Assembly of the Kingdom of Cambodia on “Parliamentary Diplomacy, Think Tank Cooperation and People-to-People Relations” as part of the International Conference on the “Establishment of Sustainable Peace in the Asia-Pacific based on Universal Humanism: For Reunification of the Korean Peninsula”, held on 4–5 July 2022. Twenty-three Members of Parliament from ten Commissions of the National Assembly and more than 60 international delegates attended the session. The conference issued a 16-point Statement of Recommendations.

AVI Perspective on Smart City

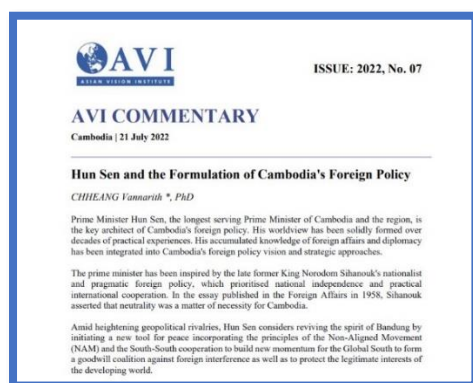

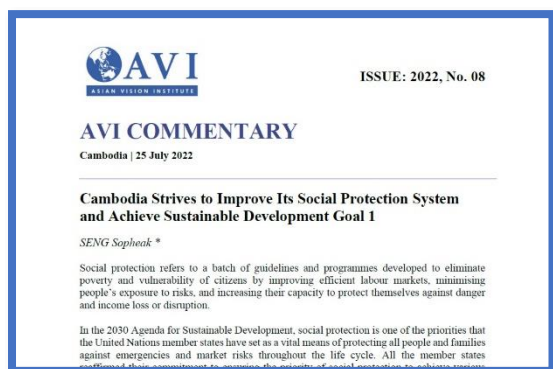
