

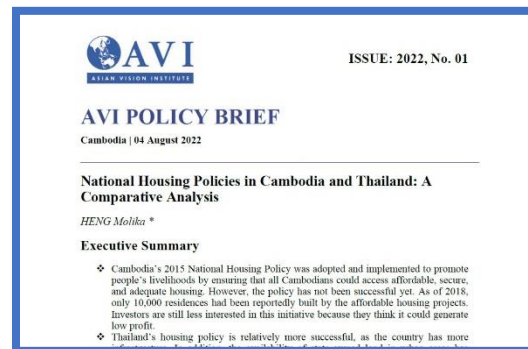
Public Seminar on “ASEAN-Japan Cooperation and Ways Forward in the Next 50 Years”

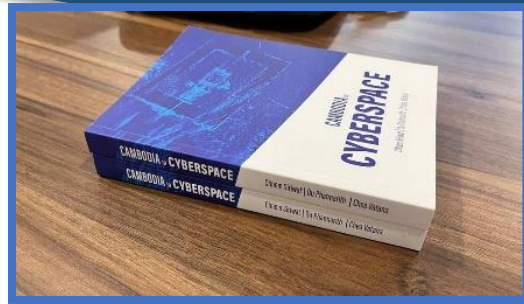
