AVI Published New Article in Fulcrum on "Making Sense of Cambodia's Reaction to AUKUS"



In his new article published by Fulcrum, Mr Bong Chansambath, Deputy Director of the Centre for Inclusive Digital Economy at the Asian Vision Institute, explains Cambodia's reaction to the AUKUS submarine deal revealed last month by the US, the UK, and Australia. He argues that Cambodia's response can be described as "lukewarm" due to its concerns about what AUKUS will do to regional stability, the international nuclear non-proliferation regime, and the West's indifferent attitude towards Cambodia's maritime security needs.
